### TEXTURED STOLE

Test Knit by Lacy Province

**SIZE** ~ 62" long (excluding fringe) and  
10" wide

### GAUGE

Approximately 2.25 per inch on US#13  
but gauge doesn't matter much here as  
long as you like the fabric you are  
producing

### MATERIALS

Curious Creek Fibers ~ **1 skein** each of  
Abuko (50 g / 88 yds), Kalahari (50 g / 87  
yds), and Kilimanjaro (100 g / 121 yds) and  
**2 skeins** of Shira (50 g / 86 yds)

1 pair size US #13 or #15 needles

Tapestry needle

### PATTERN

You may want to cut your fringe before  
starting your knitting, then you will be  
assured of having enough for a full and lush  
fringe. We used 16" fringe pieces to create  
an 8" finished fringe.

With Abuko, LOOSELY CO 136 stitches  
and knit one row.

Switch to Shira and knit two rows

Switch to Kalahari and knit two rows

Switch to Shira and knit two rows

Switch to Kilimanjaro and knit two rows

Switch to Shira and knit two rows

Switch to Abuko and knit to rows

Repeat sequence until yarn is gone. Bind  
off LOOSELY.

(Sequence is two rows of each: Abuko-  
Shira-Kalahari-Shira-Kilimanjaro-Shira-  
Abuko)
