



## Garden Trellis Scarf or Stole in Arusha



### Materials

Two 95 g. skeins of Curious Creek Fibers  
“Arusha” in two different colorways.  
US #15 needles, Tapestry needle



Stole knit by Hollis Bischoff of Full Thread Ahead

### Size—Scarf

Approximately 60” long and 5½” wide uses one full skein; for a stole, cast on 34 stitches and use both skeins

To reduce or increase the width of the scarf, add or subtract the number of stitches cast on by multiples of four.

### Colorway combination suggestions:

Sample Scarf & Stole shown in Anemone & Glacier Lakes

Glacier Lakes & Autumn in New England  
Glacier Lakes & Birches in Norway  
Glacier Lakes & Sunrise on Daffodils  
Glacier Lakes & Early Sunset  
Glacier Lakes & Anemone  
Anemone & Sunrise on Daffodils  
Autumn in New England & Savanna Grasses  
Autumn in New England & Sunrise on Daffodils  
Savanna Grasses & Birches in Norway

These are just a few of the very successful combinations we have used for our colorways. Color is an organic and very personal experience; go ahead, try something new, choose two colors that make you happy and go for it!

### Pattern Stitch

Slip 1 (knitwise), K1, \*P1, YO, P2tog, K1\*  
(Multiple of 4+2)

### Scarf Pattern

Cast on 18 stitches

Work in pattern stitch on every row, switching colors every two rows, do not cut colors between rows, just bringing it up the side. Knit to desired length, bind off loosely, and weave in ends
